



Action Plan for Supporting Women's Rights

Feed Our Democracy believes that each of our small actions can add up to big change. This Action Plan for supporting Women's Rights gives you some simple steps you can take to make a difference.

ISSUES:

- Representation: Women Make up 51% of the population, but only 19% of Congress.
- Wage Gap: On average, American Women earn 80 ¢ for every dollar earned by men.
- Family Leave: The US lags behind all other developed countries in providing paid family leave, with only 14% of women in the workforce qualifying for the benefit.
- Harassment: In the United States, 83 percent of girls aged 12 to 16 experienced some form of sexual harassment in public schools.
- Reproductive Rights: 29 States are hostile or extremely hostile to abortion rights.
- Violence Against Women 1 in 5 US women has been raped in her lifetime. 1 in 4 has been the victim of domestic violence.

ACTIONS. Here are a few actions you can take now.

1. **VOTE** - More women in office means more support for women's causes and rights. Support organizations like Emily's List, which works to elect pro-choice Democratic Women into office.
2. **SUPPORT LOCAL SHELTERS** - Find and support local women's shelters at <https://www.domesticshelters.org/>.
3. **RAISE THE MINIMUM WAGE** Women make up a disproportionate share of low-wage workers. Call or write your local representatives to ask them to support raising the minimum wage.
4. **HOST A FEED OUR DEMOCRACY EVENT** (toolkit attached) to engage friends in action.
5. **DONATE** to umbrella groups like the National Organization for Women, dedicated to supporting women's rights.
